TREK BERWICK – 6hr METROGAINE or 5hr CYCLOGAINE SUNDAY 24th FEBRUARY 2013 Metrogaine 10:00 am Start - Cyclogaine 10:30 am Start

As Summer comes to an end and the chances of high 30's and 40 degree days reduce we offer you a suburban Metrogaine and Cyclogaine

You are invited to Trek Berwick by foot or bike. Originally part of the Cardinia Creek run, the town of Berwick was subdivided in 1854 and was a quiet country town until it experienced explosive growth in the 80's and 90's. Your trek will take you to a number of significant sites and heritage buildings around the area. While it's not quite as exotic as trekking Nepal there is at least one awesome view for those willing to do the climb. We promise you a great day out with healthy exercise and invite you to discover Berwick.

The event offers you suburban Rogaining, electronic timing and scoring for the Metrogaine and a mixture of Electronic and Question and Multiple choice answer scoring for the Cyclogaine. The use of electronic timing is new for Metro events and is a trial/demonstration of a new timing and scoring system that is being used successfully in other areas. This trial allows us to see an alternative way of providing checkpoints and running events – and may provide useful input to our own investigations of such systems.

Geoff Hudson has a detailed map of Berwick and environs (produced for street-orienteering) and has offered to set a Metro-Cyclogaine on it. The map offers more detail of paths through suburbia and parklands. Geoff has also developed software for a simple, self-service electronic scoring and timing system and offered to use it for this Rogaine. As we will have the developer operating the system what could go wrong? The software has,

however, proved to be accurate and stable over more than 12 months of operation for local scouts – so his offer is too good to decline.

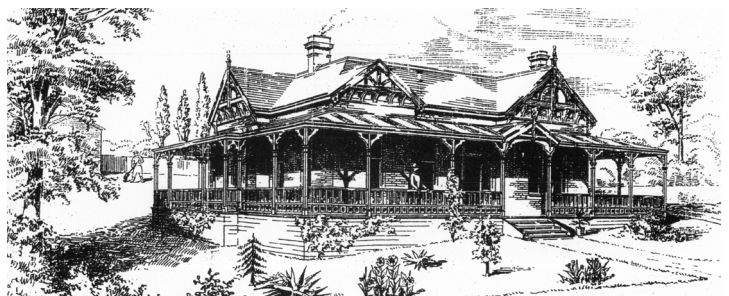
If you'd like to try out the system beforehand you can see it (and use it) in the Scout Adventure Racing Series and Mountain Bike Orienteering Summer Series currently in progress. So - Trek Berwick! Give us your feedback on both the idea of using electronic scoring rather than Question and Answer. Will Electronic scoring take some of the metal challenge out of the Metro style event? We'd like your opinion. Let us know and enjoy the day in an area not too far from home.

Note: In the case of total fire ban in Melbourne, the event will be cancelled. The VRA policy is to refund entry fees. We can do this because we are 100% volunteer run so the cost is mostly volunteer time. We can always do with additional volunteer assistance promoting and running Rogaines.

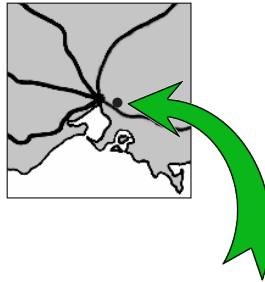

Map

A colour Street Orienteering map on
A3 at 1:20,000. These maps show the
paths in park land with great accuracy.
Colour coding out of bounds areas
clearly showing crossable parkland and
open space. There is less information
crowded onto the map making it easier
to read.

To keep the Cyclists busy the Cyclist
will have an extra map reaching into
Lysterfield Park. An area probably only
reached by the fastest riders.

Scoring

The Metrogaine will use electronic scoring
using a new system already developed by
Street Orienteers.

The Cyclogaine will have additional
checkpoints which will be the Question
and Multiple Choice Answer style we
normally use for Metrogaines.

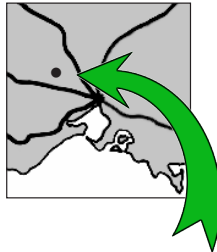

Location

The Fryers Ranges State Park, starting between Chewton and Elphinstone, off the Pyrenees Highway. Travel time from Melbourne via the Calder Hwy is about 1.5 hours.

The terrain is very open spur/gully bushland with no fences. It is undulating, not steep. It is undulating, not steep.

Course

This is the first bush event for the year so the area chosen is ideal for beginners and those wanting to practice and improve their navigation. Control placement has been chosen to encourage off track navigation in very open bushland. Experienced rogainers will be challenged by controls further from the HH. There is a lot of route choice. There are many tracks in this area. A number are being added to the map. There may be some shown on the map that are difficult to see or non-existent on the ground.

Event Format

These are two Separate Rogaines. Enter one day and volunteer on the other. Both events use the same map. Hash house catering will be provided at the conclusion of each event.

EVENT START TIME IS 11:00 AM, FINISH IS AT 5:00 PM, with Admin opening at 9:00am.

Map

The A3 map will be at a scale of 1:25000 with 10 metre contours. There is about 150 metres elevation variation across the course.

Accommodation

There may be limited camping at the HH for a few organisers. Accommodation is available in Chewton (limited) and Castlemaine (a lot) which are nearby.

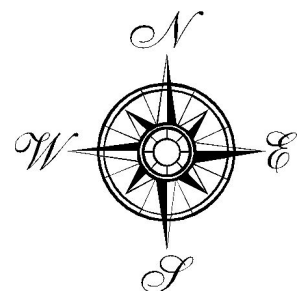

President's Piece

Welcome to the February 2013 newsletter and the new rogaining year!

I hope you had a good break over the festive season. It was a reasonably quiet time for my family, with the usual over-eating, exercise and tired kids dominating most of the Christmas-New Year break. The VRA has been planning a season of events for 2013.

Next Event – Trek Berwick

We have begun 2013 with a February event this year. The past 2 years has seen the VRA start the season in March, but this year we start with a metrogaïne / cyclogaïne event in Berwick. We hope to test out new scoring systems and will tell you more about that soon. Geoff Hudson is assisting us for this event as coordinator.

Are you an Old Scout? Can you help at Hoadley Hide at Easter? The VRA are assisting the scouts organise a small Rogaine at the Hoadley Hide event during Easter (29th March – 1 April). Hoadley Hide is the annual scouting event (started in 1952) that can be described as a large-scale initiative course and is attended by up to 300 scouts. The event is out near the Heathcote area. The VRA will set a course, and we ask for people willing to assist providing navigation training on any of the easter weekend days. The point of contact within the VRA is me, and I am working with the past rogaïne Boris Bulkin. If you can assist (and especially if you were a old past scout), we would be pleased to hear from you.

European Championships – Spain - 26 Jan 2013

Jon Sutcliffe and Thor Edgerton (who currently live in Norway) participated in the recent European Rogaining Championships in La Llacuna (near to Barcelona). Here is their brief report:

Jon and I went to Spain for the European Rogaine Champs last weekend. It is still strange to be amongst so many rogainers we don't know, and to not understand a word of the final briefing. The course was fun but not navigationally challenging (as is usual for Europe). The bush was thick and scratchy so the best strategy was to link checkpoints via tracks. That is hard on the legs and feet and not so good for non-runners. But it was fun and many of the checkpoints were placed on interesting features like ruins, caves, lookouts and kilns. We came 6th out of 20 in mixed vets class. Happy with that given training for a rogaïne is challenging during a nordic winter.

VRF-IRF Liaison Officer

Calling for expressions of interest for the position of VRF-IRF Liaison Officer. A description of the position is below. If anyone is interested please contact neil.phillips@bigpond.com

Background: the International Rogaining Federation is registered (incorporated) in the State of Victoria, Australia. The IRF banking and the registration of its Constitution are in Victoria.

It is unlikely that IRF banking can be effectively relocated to a new country each time changes occur on the Executive. This means that the functions of banking and of meeting incorporation governance requirements in the State of Victoria may need to occur without any Executive member being resident in Victoria.

One way to maintain a functioning banking system and incorporation is to have these functions overseen for the IRF under guidance of the Victorian Rogaining Association.

Purpose: the VRA-IRF Liaison role is designed to meet the governance and banking requirements of the IRF in the State of Victoria. Day-to-day activities of banking, financial record keeping and arranging of auditing would lie with the VRA-IRF Liaison Officer, under the supervision of the IRF Secretary / Treasurer. The IRF Secretary / Treasurer and Executive would maintain a strategic role in finance, the budget and decision making about expenditure and revenue.

Output: the plan is to introduce these duties in stages over time:

1. Manage the IRF bank account under direction from the IRF Executive.
2. Receive monies into the IRF bank account.
3. Make payments from the IRF bank account as directed by the IRF Executive.
4. Maintain banking account details so that the IRF Treasurer can have IRF accounts audited on an annual basis, and an annual IRF budget prepared.
5. Attend to all compliance issues that are necessary for the IRF as an incorporated sporting association in the State of Victoria. This would include a Victorian residential address, annual return, notification of all constitution changes to the Department of Justice, and occasional communication with the Department as required.
6. Attend to incoming IRF correspondence and pass on all mail and enquiries to the IRF Secretary / Treasurer.
7. Answer general enquiries that come to the IRF about rogaining, and make the Secretary / Treasurer aware of these.
8. Manage the marketing and sale of IRF promotional products.

Resources: The VRA-IRF Liaison Officer will be a non-voting co-opted Observer on Council and will have access to IRF discussions and decision-making processes. This access to the IRF Council will ensure that the Liaison Officer is kept informed about council deliberations and has direct access to advice and assistance in performing the role.

Timeframe: the IRF financial year ends on 31 December. Correspondence and banking are on-going roles throughout the year, budgeting takes place towards the end of each year, auditing occurs in January – February and the annual incorporation statement is due April-May.
