What is Your Criteria for a Perfect Rogaine?

Entire course be set in State Forest with little or no public land? Open Eucalypt forest that has little or no undergrowth? Very little climbing? Great course with lots of route choice? Navigationally challenging? An area that has lots of history? The duration of the event not longer than 6 hours? The choice of either Saturday or Sunday to compete? Close to a town with shops, hotel and accommodation? Plenty of room to camp at the HH if so desired? Caters for both the family and runner?

Well the NO Name Rogaine ticks all the boxes. The event is situated in the beautiful Dunolly-Tarnagulla State Forest.

This area known for its Iron Bark Eucalypt trees is open with little or no undergrowth, and gently [undulating](#). The highest relief is approximately 80 metres and this is only in a small section to the North. The rest of the time the climb is not more than 3 or 4 contours. (30 to 40 metres). Hence, navigation can be very challenging at times.

The recent rains have made this area very picturesque with an abundance of wild flowers. The native birds are prevalent throughout the course.

You will undoubtedly come across a variety of fauna in particular Black Wallabies and Eastern Grey Kangaroos in this area.

This area known as the Golden Triangle is renowned for its gold mining history and as a consequence there are remnants of mining dotted all over the place. In fact some of the biggest nuggets in Australia's goldmining history were found nearby.

Hence, if you keep one eye on the map and the other on the ground you may just become the richest rogaing ever.

The Naming of the Event

Just prior to arriving at the Hash House you will pass the Historic Waanyarra Cemetery. Outside the south western boundary of the cemetery and the road you will pass a lone grave. This grave is said to belong to a female that was scolded, ridiculed and persecuted by the town's people, for what reason we do not know. The hatred was so great they would not let her be buried inside the cemetery and also destroyed all of her records, hence the grave with no name. Inside the cemetery there are also 39 graves without names. Based on this information or should I say no information we have called this event the... NO Name Rogaine

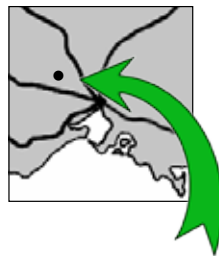

Course

The No Name Rogaine is situated in the beautiful iron bark forest in the Golden triangle in Victoria.

The Iron Bark forest is gently undulating with the highest relief of approximately 80 metres. The course is fast with little or no undergrowth.

This area offers a great navigational challenge whilst at the same time caters for all levels of competitors whether it be walkers, families or novices.

Camping is available overnight at the hash house. It is about 2:15 drive from Melbourne. There is also a number of mountain bike tracks in the area to ride on the other day. It is in the Laurie and dunnolly state forests.

Close to Dunolly. 23km north of Maryborough and 30 km west of Maldon

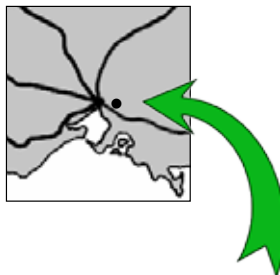
