The Daylesford Dash 2 x 6 hour events 25th and 26th May, 2013

The country town of Daylesford, about 80 minutes (120km) from Melbourne GPO, hosts this year's Schools 6 hour events in May. Situated about 30km north of the Western Hwy from Ballan, the open eucalypt and pine forest areas are traversed by numerous tracks and are a perfect setting for families, beginners and the more experienced. The bush is easily traversable throughout, with clearly defined features very accurately mapped close to the Hash House and reasonably fast moving throughout. What more could you ask for?

Following the discovery of gold in the district in 1851 Daylesford, Hepburn and other settlements quickly established. Fortune seekers from all around the world converged upon the golden triangle of Victoria, including a large contingent of Italian speaking Swiss and a large population of Chinese, though the majority were of Anglo-Saxon background. The diverse heritage is still evident in the district and numerous diggings areas exist on the course.

The event is open to the public on both days, and additionally hosts the 2013 Victorian Schools Rogaining Championships on Sunday 26th May, with VRA personnel available as coaches for novice teams (school or public), who can advise on route planning and head out into the bush with you to get you started in finding your first checkpoints.

Checkpoints have been set with novices and school teams in mind with a healthy number of checkpoints located within range and easy navigation of the Hash House starting area. The Hash House is set in the Daylesford Speedway, which backs onto the Hepburn Springs Park eucalypt forest and nearby Wombat State forest. There will be a coffee van on site on both days.

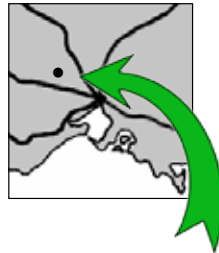

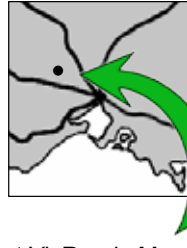

The HH is at VicRoads Map 45 Grid F6,
near the cnr of Cherrytree Rd (going north
from the HH) and Graytown-Mt. Camel Rd
going east from the HH.

Location
The Hash House is about 130 km north of
Melbourne. The nearest town is Heathcote,
which is about 20 km south of the event
area. The event location has a gold mining
past, and the Heathcote area is known for
its vineyards and wineries.

Course
The course is entirely in native box
ironbark forest. Part of the course will be
in the Heathcote Graytown National Park.
The terrain is gently undulating with sparse
undergrowth allowing easy cross country
travel, but careful navigation is often
required.

Map
The map is based on the new VicMap
1:30000 series, with 10 metre contours
and aligned to Grid North.

Coaching involves checking teams' route choices and equipment and some checking of level of navigational ability: Do students know how to read a map, find north and use the map and compass to work out which way to walk between checkpoints?

Coaches also check that students know what to do if they get lost or sustain an injury. Some coaches go out on the course with the less confident teams until satisfied that they will be safe.

Tallarook Ranges - wrapup

An event close to Melbourne, an 11am start time, and a warm April day saw a huge number of people come up to the Tallarook Ranges for the 6hr and 12hr rogaine set in the lovely Tallarook Ranges just outside Broadford.

Grant Jeffrey set a fair course that provided gentle navigation in hilly terrain with occasional patches of thick scrub. Novice teams were rewarded with a lot of checkpoints close to the Hash House, while faster teams could get to the outer edges of the map for some larger points. The Hash House area was changed from our previously used picnic area (since it was being renovated), and other than annoyingly small children on even louder and smaller motorbikes at times, the area proved to be a suitable location.

We had 273 people (104 teams) in the 6 hour event, with Ross and James Taylor getting 1130 points in the 6 hours. We had 65 people (28 teams) in the 12 hour event with two teams cleaning the course (getting all the checkpoints in the allotted time). Both teams of Andrew Baker and Brett Sparkes, along with Vic Sedunary and Merv Trease reached every checkpoint during the 12 allotted hours, with Andrew and Brett awarded overall winners coming home first after 11 hours and 3 minutes. Well done to you all.

A big thank you to all the volunteers that assisted with the event, especially Grant Jeffrey, Denise Pike and Peter Grover (Admin), Catering (Helen Alexander who did an awesome job in managing a very busy catering area) and Karen Robinson (Navlight) with equipment being done by Peter Brooks and Franco Lombardi. Big thanks to everyone who additionally volunteered their time and effort for the event.

Daylesford Dash Rogaine – Saturday and Sunday 25th & 26th May
The next event is the schools event in Daylesford. Traditionally held in June, it has been moved this year as the Australian Champs are held in June this year and it was also deemed to be more suitable to conduct the Schools and Scouts champs earlier.

The Schools and Scouts event is our largest event of the year, and we encourage members to rogain on one day and assist on the other. Daylesford is a lovely area, full of lakes, springs, cafes and bookshops. With the leaves turning colour there at the moment, the area is looking more beautiful than ever.

Both days are public event days, with a normal 6 hour rogaine being conducted from 10am – 4pm. On Sunday we additionally conduct a 5 hour Schools Champs rogaine from 10.30am – 3.30pm. Yes, the kids come back early and get all the best cheese toasties, but that is assuming that they don't get lost!

I've been to a lot of rogaines, but I don't think I have ever been able to see the first checkpoint from the middle of the Hash House. In this event you will, and it is only 75m away. The question is whether you will go for it?

The area is a mixture of open bushland and forest area. There are a large amount of tracks in the area, and checkpoints are set on strong features to assist beginner Rogainers. Checkpoints get progressively harder at the perimeter of the map, and a lot of the area can be travelled through quickly. There is a bit of thick blackberry and other scratchy undergrowth at places, but the course has been designed to avoid most of that unless you are well

off track. The Hash House is at the Daylesford Speedway, next door to Victoria Oval about 1km before Daylesford town centre.

VRA Annual General Meeting – 23rd May 2013

The annual general meeting is scheduled for 23rd May from 7.30pm. The evening has about 45 minutes of formalities, then a social evening with a slideshow and guest speaker. Dinner is provided and all are welcome. The committee is looking for anyone wanting to assist over the 2014.

Australian Rogaining Champs – 22-23 June 2013

Entries are now open for the Aus Champs in Far North Queensland. The event is situated wholly within private property about 40 mins from Cairns. Transport is available to the Hash House from the airport. The course will have an excellently stocked Hash House (HH) and 2 all night cafes (ANC). Event terrain will be primarily spur/ gully with open woodland to tall open forest and the only rainforest being riparian along main creeks. 'Wait a while' has not been seen by field workers on the event course. Black spear grass may be present on small areas of the 188 sq km event course.
