THE EMU CHASE 2 x 6 hr ROGAINE SATURDAY 17th or SUNDAY 18th AUGUST 2013 10am to 4pm each day

The City of Greater Bendigo is surrounded by many pockets of the Greater Bendigo National Park and state forests not included in the National Park. These pockets all seem to be too small for Rogaines.

In the last 15 years only two bush Rogaines have been conducted in the Bendigo area. The western half of The Emu Chase course was last used back in 1997 for the Summer Madness Upside Down 12hr Rogaine. The eastern half of the course appears to have never been used before. To create a 6hr course we will be using two forests that are separated by a wedge of farm land along the Emu Creek. There is a road at the north and south end of about a kilometre connecting the two forests.

The terrain is clearly defined spurs and gullies with no big climbs. The altitude gain from highest to lowest point is only 150m. The ground cover vegetation ranges from thin to none at all. Easy travel cross country is to be expected with the option to take the tracks with reasonable confidence they will be as mapped. Checkpoints are set well back from track to keep them out of sight. Stolen checkpoints are both frustrating for competitors, challenging for Navlight scoring and costly for the VRA to replace and we don't want to lose one of our new rechargeable punches first time out.

There has been gold mining in the area although not a lot of old mines to be seen however take care, they are there. You will see many water channels contouring through the forest. There is a main water supply channel used to move water down to dams closer into Bendigo. The channels were built in the goldmining era. Other than the main channel many others appear to be maintained by local land owners to catch and deliver water to their dams. Following a few of them I gained the impression they have been recently extended or at least had time invested in ensuring they are effective.

One unusual feature of this map is a main road passing through the map that will be mapped as out of bounds. Because it is a 100km zone with double white lines due to limited visibility there will be designated areas to cross at and no travelling along the road. The checkpoint locations will guide you to cross at the intended crossing points. Teams running very late may be tempted to travel along the road but I'm confident you will all obey the rules in the best interest of road safety and our sport.

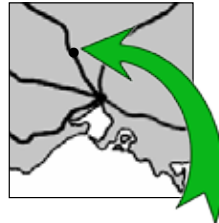

Location

The course area is located 5 to 10 km south east of Bendigo and 145km from Melbourne CBD to the Hash House site.

The terrain is very open spur and gully bushland with no fences. It is undulating and not steep.

Course

The course is set across a State Forest and a National Park. The two forest areas are separated by the Emu Creek and farm land along the creek. There are two 1km roads connection between the forests for the teams expecting to bag lots of Checkpoints.

Close in, the Check points are closer together. Further out they will be about a kilometre apart with the potential to be more challenging.

Event Format

These are two Separate Rogaines. Enter either day or both. Both events use the same map. Hash house catering will be provided at the conclusion of each event.

EVENT START TIME IS 10:00 AM, FINISH IS AT 4:00 PM, with Admin opening at 8:00am.

Map

The A3 map at a scale of 1:25000 with 10 metre contours. There is about 150 metres elevation variation across the course with mostly well defined spurs and gullies.

The Map has more tracks mapped than our usual Rogaine maps however not all tracks are mapped and some are revegetating well.

The accurate tracks are thanks to Bendigo Orienteers who have allowed us to use this extra detail. The map will be of the normal Rogaine Maps Standards and appearance other than the extra tracks and dams. The extra tracks will enable you to decide between the direct cross country option or less direct track option.

Accommodation

There are plenty of accommodation options in Bendigo and a hotel at Harcourt. Camping for volunteers at the Hash House site.

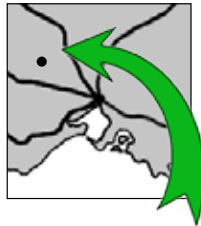

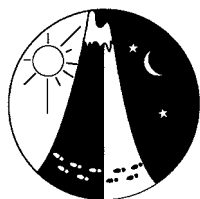
