## WALLABIES IN WOMBAT 6 HR AND 12HR ROGAINES SATURDAY 14th SEPTEMBER 2013 6HR 10AM TO 4PM SATURDAY 12 HR 10AM TO 10PM SATURDAY

In setting this rogaine, we have spent considerable time debating why this has been called the Wombat State Forest. To date we have seen one wombat and hundreds of wallabies and our extensive research didn't give us a satisfactory answer so...Wallabies in Wombat was born.

Why come to the Wallabies in Wombat Rogaine? Varied terrain including wet and dry eucalyptus forest, some beautiful views, watercourses and gullies. For those who want a gentle stroll or to take out the young family, the event has been set with you in mind. Checkpoints have been placed to make full use of the track networks including the lovely Lerderderg walking track. You could even bring a picnic!

For those who like to be challenged, the outer edges of the

map are set to ensure you are off track and up and down some hills. For all teams, there are plenty of checkpoints to make route choice interesting and tempt you cross country.

Transportation is a breeze with the hash house being located just off the Blackwood Trentham road and only 1 hour 20 minutes from Melbourne. There is ample space for camping 700 metres from the HH if you want to make the most of the location or to rest your tired legs after the 12 hour event. Alternatively, there are limited accommodation options in the Blackwood area.

All in all, the Wallabies in Wombat rogaine will be unreal. You should come, and bring a wombat with you!

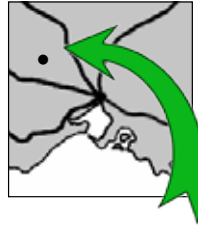

# 11th World Rogaining Championships

Oh to be in Russia when the gun goes off!

After months of planning, we were set off in the 11th World Rogaining Championships near Pustoshka (500 km south of St Petersburg).

We had arrived via Moscow and survived the 550 km hair raising bus trip to the event site - strong bladders were the order of the day as stopping was not a priority. However passing everything else on the road was!

My other team members were Alan Cooke and Geoff Lyons - neither of whom had done a 24 hour rogaine before nor had they found a checkpoint in the dark. Our team manager was Heather Leslie whose job it was to motivate, support and meld the team as well as liaise with other support teams.

We were greeted at the event site by a catering unit of the Russian army and thousands of mosquitoes. On receiving the map, the attendance of the mozzies was not surprising as there was almost more lakes, canals and marshes on the map than forest and cleared land.

Our plan was to complete a small loop to the east, sticking to tracks as much as possible and avoiding the marshes and lakes, and then to sweep down south. The gun went off and the 300+ teams set off. Initially we progressed well and we congratulated ourselves on risking a canal crossing and arriving at the CP before a number of faster teams.

However, after our 4th checkpoint we crossed a marsh through knee deep mud. This meant wet feet early. We missed the next checkpoint and re-arranged our course to get to a point to re-position ourselves. After this we progressed steadily through a number of checkpoints but soon realised we needed to cut sections of our planned course.

We had a long rest just on dark (11pm). We then attempted CP, one of

many that were in a depression - marked on the map similar to a knoll but with an internal mark indicating it goes down rather than up! We then walked through the night, collecting all CPs attempted.

By morning we were starting to suffer from our wet feet. They were swelling, hurting and we were tiring. We managed to slowly pick up further CPs but only after a long traverse through a stretch of shoulder high nettles - the only compensation being the fields of blueberries and the occasional raspberries.

After 23 hours we staggered into the finish - proud of our effort. We had set out to walk through the night and to have fun. We were covered in hundreds of mosquito, horsefly and March fly bites and our knees were stinging from the nettles. And our feet were swollen, blistered and sore. The mozzies proved too much for some teams who abandoned rather than be eaten.

There were some great medal winning performances from Australians.
